Top 3 teams & top 8 individuals per section to qualify for the 2018 Championship at Ascot Under Wychwood on 14/15th July sponsored by Horse Events.

Qualified teams / Individuals are asked to email the Championship organiser to confirm whether they plan on taking up their place at the final within two weeks of qualifying.

Substitution- a qualified team may substitute up to two riders at the final but these riders must have competed in one of the 10 qualifying events or the BE equivalent at the same height.

Individual qualifications- it is the horse/rider combination that qualify so no substitution is possible
